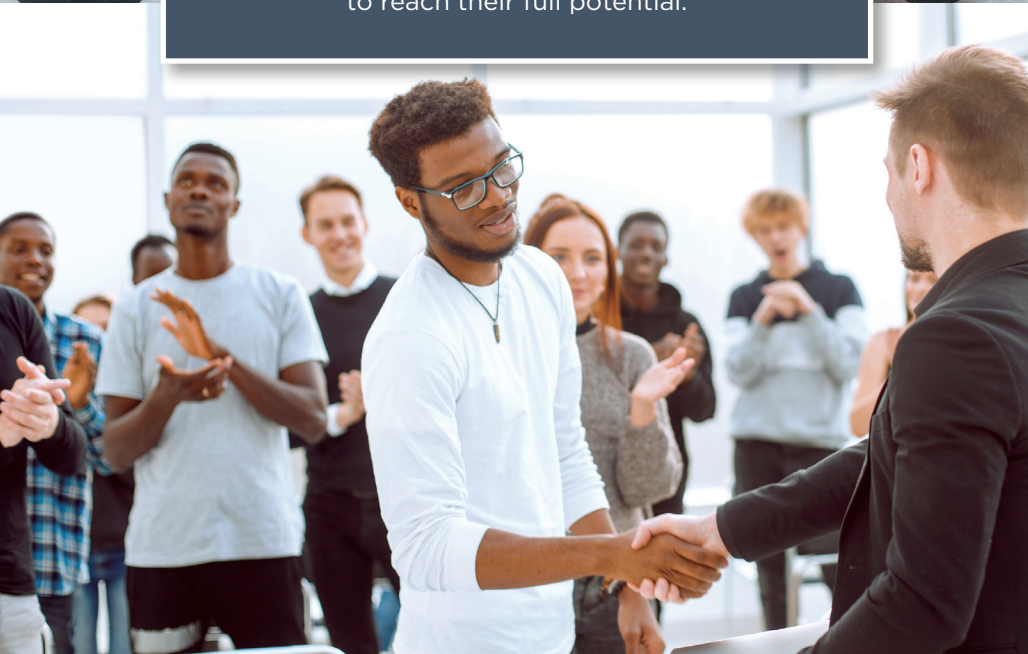


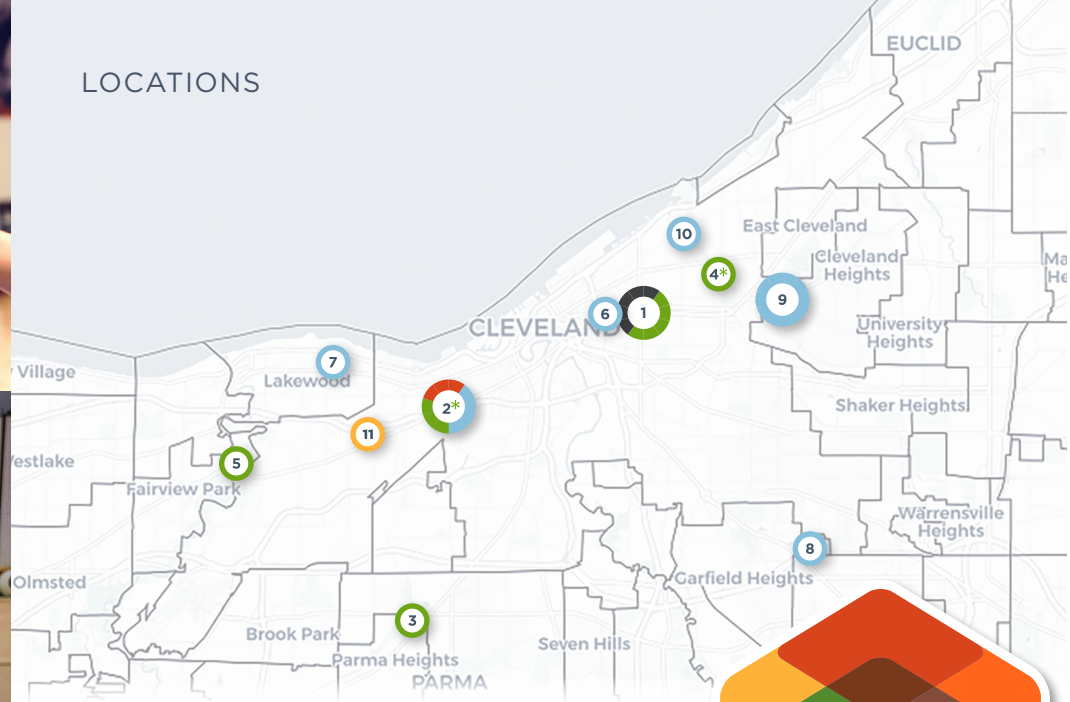

## RESIDENTIAL YOUTH PROGRAMS

The Centers and Cleveland Christian Home (CCH) have partnered, enabling The Centers to expand access to the full continuum of behavioral health services for children and adolescents.

The residential treatment programs provide year-round, 24/7 care and support for youth in the custody of the Cuyahoga County Department of Children & Family Services (CCDCFS). Services, including medical, therapeutic, and educational, are provided for youth who have experienced severe trauma or abuse and/or who may have significant emotional or behavioral health challenges.

T-Suites specializes in providing short-term emergency housing and support for youth who have been displaced in the child welfare system. This unique approach in residential care provides a 1:1 staff/resident ratio, safe and inviting spaces designed specifically for teens, special services to support the complex needs of each youth, and a 24/7 care team that includes an onsite therapist and nurse.

## EL BARRIO WORKFORCE PROGRAM

Opportunity happens here. Our free, bilingual, hybrid workforce programs are open to anyone 18 years or older - no high school diploma required. We offer short-term career training, specialized industry certifications, and job matching services with numerous regional and national employers. We also provide the only full-time Spanish language general job readiness training track in Ohio. Transportation and supportive service assistance is also available.
